- 3. Pledge to the Flag was recited.
- Motion by Mercier second by Lucht: To adopt the posted agenda for April 11, 2016. Voice vote all aye. Motion carried.
- 5. Motion by Mercier second by Olson: To approve March 14, 2016 Minutes Voice vote all aye. Motion carried.
- 6. Financial report presented by Treasure Geitz.

Chairman Demaskie reminded the board that the town board agreed and signed a resolution in 2015 to follow Sauk County Zoning Ordinance Chapter 7. In Chapter 7 Ordinance Sauk County does allow such garages and/or structures on vacant parcels, therefore when a land use permit for a structure is granted from Sauk County Planning and Zoning Dept. the town board cannot stop someone from doing so.

Motion by Lucht second by Mercier: To approve to take out a loan in the amount of \$950,000.00 Resolution number 2016-4-22 for ten year at an interest rate of 2.25% with the State Bank of Cazenovia Roll Call Vote- Mercier-aye; Olson-aye; Lucht-aye; Stout-aye; Demaskie-aye. Roll Call Vote All aye (5). Motion carried.
- 14. Motion by Stout second by Lucht: To approve moving funds into the following categories: \$150,000.00 add to the Public Works account for roads repair; \$10,000.00 Fire Dept. Equipment Fund; \$5,000.00 Police Equipment Funds; \$15,000.00 Public Works Equipment Fund; \$5,000.00 Fire Department Building Fund into the LGIP account funds. Roll call vote: Mercier-aye. Olson-aye; Lucht-aye; Stout-aye; Demaskie-aye. Roll Call vote all aye. Motion carried.
- 15. Don Mc Cume briefly updated the town board on the process of the Neighborhood Watch program on Lake Redstone.
- 16. Police report presented by Officer Astle. Astle commented the Police Squad is back from the body shop.
- 17. Fire Dept. Update- There are a few more supplies to be ordered for the Brush Truck and that should be completed in a couple months. Election of Officers will be at the May meeting.
- 18. Motion by Stout second by Lucht to approve the purchase of a laptop computer for the town. Voice vote 4-aye 1 nay. Motion carried.
- 19. Public Comment- Chuck Ecklund-dislikes placement of public comment at the end of the agenda.
