

# ANNUAL TOWN MEETING NOTICE

## APRIL 16, 2019

The 2019 AANNUAL MEETING for the Town of La Valle will be held at the Town hall, 314 State Hwy 33/58 on Tuesday April 16, 2019 and begins at 7:00 P.M. The following items will be discussed and considered:

1. Call the Meeting to order
2. Pledge to the Flag
3. Minutes from 2018 Annual Town Meeting
4. Introduction of Town Board Members
5. Review 2018 Year to Date report
6. Discussion and potential action on matters of interest to town residents.  
(Discussions subject to advisory motion and second by Town residents)
7. Motion to adjourn the Spring Annual Meeting

The town meeting is the meeting of the electors, that is, the people and not a meeting of the town board.

Town government is covered in Chapter 60, Wisconsin Statutes. The powers that may be exercised by the people at a town meeting, and that are binding on the town, are set forth in § 60.10.

The town meeting may act with authority only on those things authorized by State Statute 60.10(1). Actions on other matters are advisory only.

The powers of the town meeting are of three types: (1) *direct powers*, which authorize the town meeting to direct certain actions and activities, such as the authority to levy a tax and the power to combine certain offices, e.g., that of town clerk and treasurer; fix compensation for town board offices; Establish or abolish the office of constable; Establish election of town board members by means of numbered seats. (2) *directives or grants of authority to the town board*, such as authorizing the town board to adopt the local tax levy or purchase land or buildings; and (3) *authorizations to the town board to appropriate money for specific purposes*, such as the conservation of natural resources or civic functions.
