

La Valle Town Board Meeting
February 27, 2017
MINUTES

1. Chairman Demaskie called the February 27, 2017 Town Board meeting to order at 7:00pm.
2. Roll call: Mercier-present; Geils-aye; Lucht -aye; Geitz-aye; Demaskie-aye. All present.
3. Pledge Allegiance to the Flag.
4. Motion by Mercier second by Lucht: To Adopt Posted Agenda for February 27, 2017 with moving item number 10 under item number 6 ATV UTV Amend Chapter 8.02 All-Terrain. Voice vote all aye. Motion carried.
5. Motion by Geitz second by Geils: To Approve Minutes from February 13, 2017. Voice vote all aye. Motion carried.
6. Motion by Mercier second by Geils: To Amend Ordinance number 8.02 All-Terrain Vehicle ATV/UTV of the Code of Ordinances, and to Adopt Ordinance number 02-2017-ATV adding © to Section number 8.02.4 In addition, STH 58 from Jessop Road to the southerly limits of the Village of La Valle is designated an ATV/UTV Route for the purpose of crossing two bridges on STH-58 over the Little Baraboo River. And Section 8.02.06B (1) Operation is restricted to the hours between 7:00 A. M. and 9:00 P.M. Voice vote all aye. Motion carried.
7. The Board discussed Ordinance number 7.05-7.0511. Motion by Demaskie second by Mercier: To revised the code with the changes that were discussed and send to the town attorney to review and recommendation before adopting the ordinance. Voice vote all aye. Motion carried.
8. The board briefly discussed the Town Employee Handbook and it was the consensus of the board to postpone and review the handbook at a future board meeting.
9. Postpone Town of La Valle Police Ordinance when someone from the Police Dept. is present.
10. Motion by Mercier second by Lucht: To approve to publish a legal notice in the newspaper to hire 2017 Seasonal part Time Boat patrol staff the draft copy of the notice the police department provided, text words only no pictures, no letterhead in the ad. Voice vote all aye. Motion carried.

11. Road Report and Updates presented by Public Works Director Al Johnson.

11a. Quotes from recycling companies postpone to t a future board meeting, due to nothing was received from the recycling companies in time for the meeting.

11b. Recycling Site Hours-Motion by Demaskie second by Mercier: To Disallow a resident from using the Town hall Dumpster at the Town Hall who is dumping their personal household trash and commingled recyclables items into the town hall dumpster; and to send a letter to the individual with the days and hours the Waste and Recycling Site is open as follows: Winter hours: Saturday 8am to Noon; Sunday 1:00pm to 4:00pm; second Wednesday of the month 1:00pm to 4:00pm November to April; Summer hours: Saturday 8am to Noon; Sunday 1:00pm to 5:00pm; every Wednesday 1:00pm to 5:00pm, Closed Holiday's. The individual will need to find a way to use the Waste and Recycling Site to dispose his household trash and recyclables and will no longer be allowed to use the town hall dumpster for their personal use. Voice vote all aye. Motion carried.

11c. It was the consensus of the Town Board to use the same contractor as last year to put the Buoys in on Lake Redstone.

11d. It was the consensus of the board to appoint Supervisor Lucht and Chair Demaskie to help the Public Words director to select the roads for the 2017 road repair.

11e. Future purchase of Plow Truck(s) to be discussed at a future board meeting.

12. Motion by Lucht second by Mercier: To delete older information on the town's website and retain 2016 and current 2017 Town Meetings Agenda's and Minutes on the website. Voice vote all aye. Motion carried.

13. Public Comment-Dick Fish ATV Ordinance changes.

14. Motion by Mercier second by Geils: To Adjourn the meeting at 8:40pm. Voice vote all aye. Motion carried.
