1. Chairman Demaskie called the June 14, Town Board Meeting to order 7:06pm. Roll Call: Mercier-present; Geils-present; Rego-present; Geitz-present; Demaskie-present. All members present.
2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
3. Motion by Mercier second by Rego: To adopt the posted agenda for June 14, 2021. Voice vote- all aye. Motion carried.
4. Motion by Geitz second by Mercier: To approve the minutes for May 10, 2021 Town Board Minutes and May 10, 2021 Public Hearing Minutes. Voice vote-all aye. Motion carried.
