

La Valle Town Board Meeting
Monday November 10, 2025

1. Chairman Demaskie called the November 10, 2025 Town Board meeting to order at 7:00pm. Roll Call: Mercier-present; Geils-present; Geitz-present; Demaskie: present. All members present.
2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
3. Motion by Mercier second by Geitz: To adopt the posted agenda for November 10, 2025. With one revision moving item number **11b** under item number 6: Quotes from Recycling and Trash Companies. Voice vote, all aye. Motion carried.
4. Motion by Mercier second by Geitz: To Approve the Town Board Meeting Minutes for October 13, 2025. Voice vote, all aye. Motion carried.
